AN ORDINANCE ASSIGNING ANNEXED LANDS TO WARDS, 10 AM 8 19 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 04-542, the City of Gentry submitted to the voters the issue of annexation of certain lands to the City Limits of the City of Gentry; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Election Commissioners in and for the State of Arkansas, County of Benton has certified the results of the November 02, 2004 General Election, certifying that the question of annexation was passed and approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS, it is now incumbent upon the City Council for the City of Gentry to assign the annexed lands to voting Wards within the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENTRY, ARKANSAS:

- 1. That those lands accepted into the City limits of the City of Gentry described as Tract "A" on Exhibit "A" attached hereto are hereby assigned to Ward 3;
- 2. That those lands accepted into the City limits of the City of Gentry described as Tract "B" on Exhibit "A" attached hereto are hereby assigned to Ward 4; and
- 3. That those lands accepted into the City limits of the City of Gentry described as Tract "C" on Exhibit "A" attached hereto are hereby assigned to Ward 1.
- 4. Emergency. Assignment to voting Wards needs to be made immediately as part of the orderly annexation process. Accordingly, the Council finds that this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health and safety shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.





ORDINANCE NO. 04-542

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF GENTRY, ARKANSAS, AND OTHER AFFECTED PERSONS, THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION TO SAID CITY OF GENTRY OF CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Gentry, Arkansas, that the annexation of certain hereinafter-described territory contiguous to the City of Gentry is necessary for the orderly growth of the City; and

WHEREAS, the lands proposed to be annexed meet all of the legal requirements of Arkansas Code Annotated §14-40-302; and

WHEREAS, the lands are needed for proper and orderly municipal growth, planning and development; and

WHEREAS, in light of these factors the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to annex said lands to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENTRY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Gentry and to the qualified electors within the below described territory the question of the annexation to the City of Gentry, Arkansas of the following described territory, more particularly described as follows:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"

SECTION 2. The question of annexation of the territory described above in Section 1 shall be submitted to the electors qualified to vote on this issue at the General Election to be held on the 2nd day of November, 2004. The City Clerk shall immediately notify the Benton County Clerk and the Benton County Election Commission of said question of annexation by forwarding to them a certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. If at such election a majority of the qualified electors voting in such election shall vote for such annexation, the City of Gentry shall proceed to file a description and a map of the annexed area with the County Clerk of Benton County and with the Arkansas Secretary of State. The annexation shall be included within the corporate limits of the City of Gentry thirty (30) days following the filing of the description and a map with the Benton County Clerk, or in the event an action is filed with the Benton County Circuit Court, on the date the judgment of said Court becomes final. If a majority of the qualified electors voting on the issue at the election vote against the annexation, the annexation ordinance shall be null and void.

SECTION 4. If the annexation is approved and becomes final, the following services shall be extended to the areas within three (3) years:




