

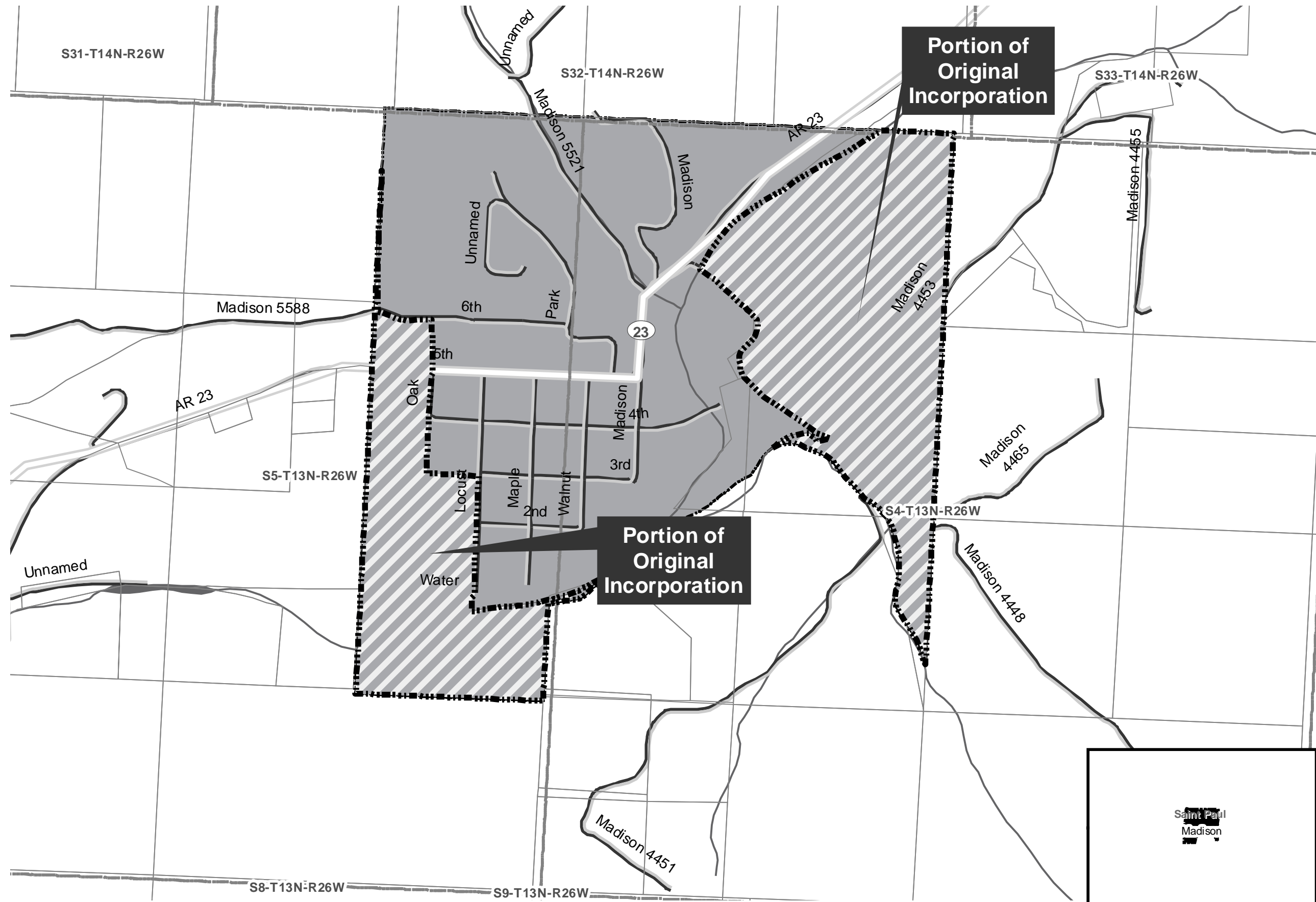
BAS Correction Portion of Original Incorporation of 1891 : City of St. Paul

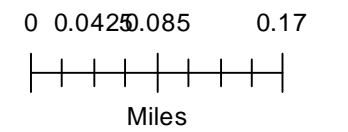
Arkansas Code 14-40-101.

the Town of St. Paul Madison
County Arkansas =

To the Honorable Judge of the County
Court of Madison County Arkansas
We the undersigned petitioners most
respectfully represent and show unto
Your Honor that we are inhabitants of
that portion of Madison County Arkansas
and are qualified voters therein embraced
within the limits of the unincorporated
town of St. Paul Madison County Ar-
kansas and as such inhabitants and
voters desire the Incorporation into a
town under the name and style of the
town of St. Paul to include the following
described territory to-wit = Beginning
at the North West corner of Block Number
Forty (40) thence running due South to a
point on the South side of White River
and due West of the South West corner
of the Block Forty Eight (48) thence along
the South line of the bank of White River
to the South West corner of said Block
48 thence along the South line of
said Block (48) back to the South East
corner of said Block 48 thence East on

the South side of White River to the bend,
or turn in said River thence in a North
Easterly direction to where Baldwin Creek
empties into White River thence East
along the South bank of Baldwin Creek
to a point where the public Road crosses
said Baldwin Creek nearest said town
of St. Paul thence due north to a point
due East of the North East corner of
block number Forty Six (46) thence
due west on and along the North line
of Blocks 46, 45, 44, 43, 42, 41 and 40
to the North West corner of said Block
40 the place of beginning which will
more fully appear by the accurate
Map hereto annexed and your petitioners
hereby suggest and name John P.
Paul as the person to prosecute said
petition and authorize him to do all
things necessary to be done and performed
in and about the Incorporation of
the Town of St. Paul in our name and
stead and to all intent and purpose
and with the same effect as we and
each of us were personally present be-
fore your Honor and for the Incorporation
of said town we will ever
