

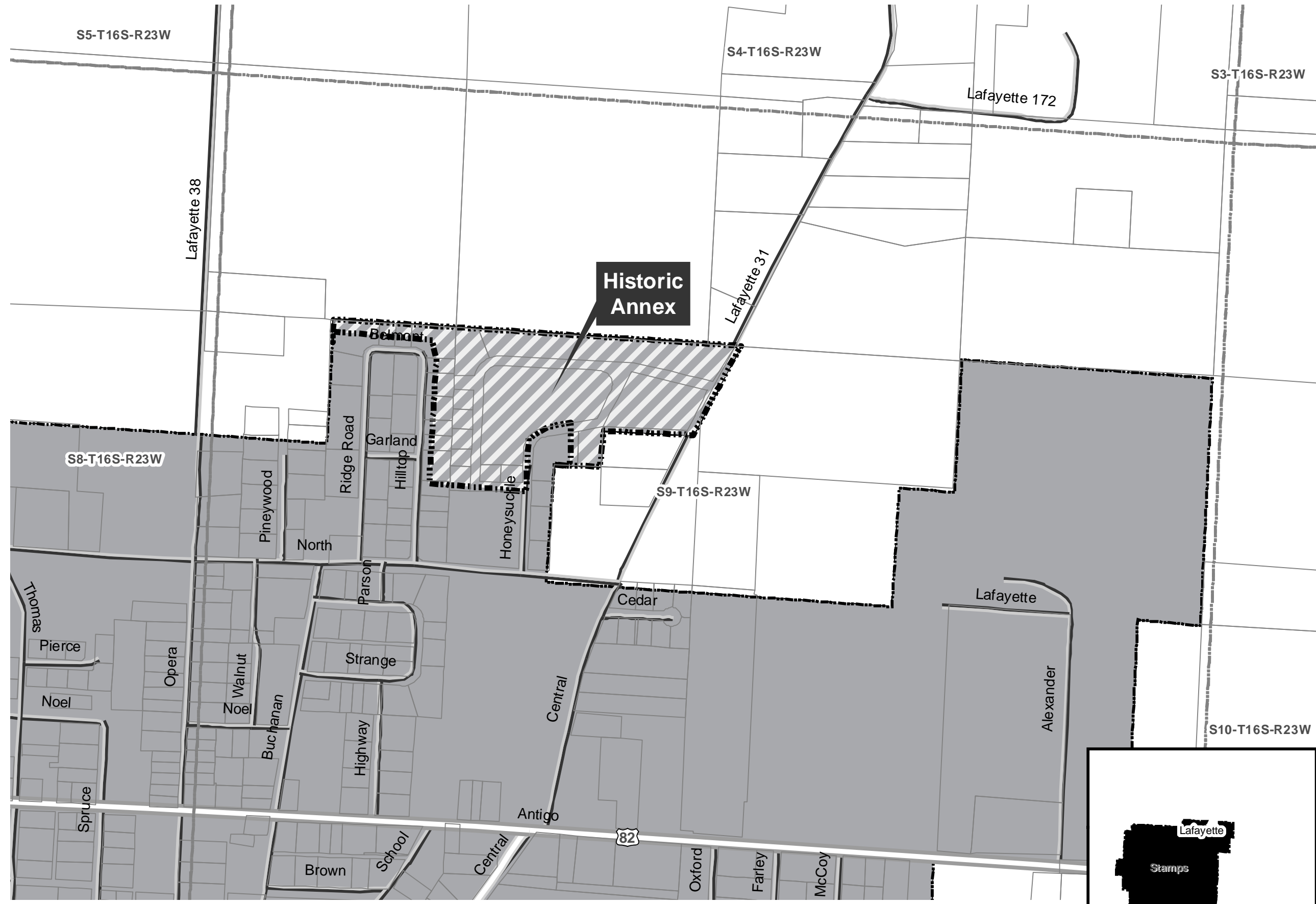

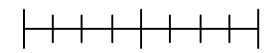

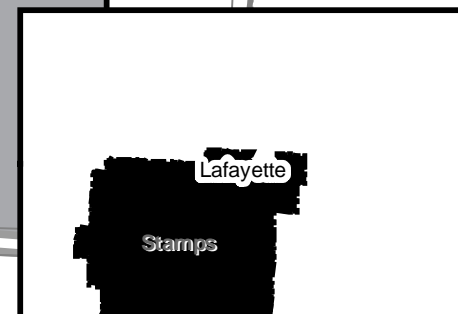

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING CERTAIN  
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY TO THE  
CITY OF STAMPS, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, Homestead Manor, Inc. ; Warren P. Blount and Meloise Blount, his wife; John L. Andrews, Jr., and Sandra Kay Andrews, his wife; Joe Ann Morehead; Thomas R. Sims and Roma H. Sims, his wife, have caused to be filed in the County Court of Lafayette County, Arkansas, a Petition praying for the annexation of certain contiguous territory to the City of Stamps, Arkansas, to-wit, in Lafayette County, Arkansas:

All of Block One and Lots One through Eight of Block Four, and all of East Honeysuckle Drive adjacent to and running in front of Lots One through Eight of Block 4 as shown on a plat representing a revision of the Honeysuckle Height Subdivision recorded in the Plat Book of Lafayette County, Arkansas, Page 87.

and,

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Lafayette County, Arkansas, after notice having been given in the manner and time provided by law, did conduct a hearing and issue an order on the 11th day of September, 1978, for the annexation of the hereinabove described lands to the City of Stamps, Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, no notice of objection of the annexation of said hereinabove described territory to the city or town authorities or agents of the petitioners for annexation has been given within thirty (30) days from the making of the Order of Annexation by the County Court of Lafayette County, Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, the annexation of said lands should be accepted by the City of Stamps, Lafayette County, Arkansas, for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the City of Stamps, Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Stamps, Arkansas, in Special session held this 12th day of October, 1978, that the hereinabove described lands be and the same are hereby accepted and annexed to the City of Stamps, County of Lafayette, State of Arkansas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Recorder be placed in the record books of the City of Stamps, Arkansas.

No contest of this annexation has been filed and no contest of this proceeding has been had.


