

To the Honorable H. Wilson Judge &c we the undersigned
Citizens and qualified voters of the town of Altus and vicinity hereby
most respectfully petition that the town of Altus be incorporated as the
law directs in such manner made and provided said incorporation to
include the following territory to wit. Beginning at the north east corner
of the north west quarter (SW^{1/4}) of the North west quarter NW^{1/4} of
Section fifteen: thence west on Section line to the north west corner of the
North East quarter of Section Sixteen thence south to the South west corner
of North East quarter of Section sixteen thence west to the north west corner
of the North East quarter of the South west quarter of Section Sixteen thence
south to the South west corner of said North East quarter of the South
west quarter of Section Sixteen thence east to the South east corner of
the North East quarter of South west quarter thence south to South west
corner of the North west quarter of the North East quarter of Section Twenty
one, thence east to the South east corner of the North west quarter of
Section Twenty two thence north to the place of beginning, all in Township
Nine @ Range 26 twenty six west. your petitioners state that they are all
Citizens and qualified voters residing within the limits of the territory prayed
to be incorporated and we hereby authorize as our representatives to prosecute





Now on this 31st day of May 1888 it being the regular April term of the County Court for Franklin County Arkansas the petition of the citizens of said town praying to have the same incorporated having been filed April 16th 1888 signed by the requisite number of inhabitants together with an accurate map or plat thereof and the notice required by law having been given of the intended application for an order of incorporation and no person remonstrating

against the same and the required number of inhabitants reside within the boundaries of said town and that the name proposed is sufficient to distinguish it from others in this State, and it appearing right and proper in the judgment of the court that the petition be granted. It is therefore ordered by the court the premises considered that the town of Altus be incorporated under the name of the town of Altus; that a copy of this record shall be forwarded by the County Clerk to the Secretary of State and another to Dr. McGraw and W. J. Brooks the agents of the petitioners with the additional certificate that a certified copy has been forwarded to the Secretary of State upon all costs being paid by petitioners, and one month after such transcript has been forwarded and delivered notice shall be given by the said agents of the petitioners of an election of officers of said incorporation consisting of a mayor five aldermen one Recorder and one Treasurer and upon the election of said officers the said town will be considered and recognized as incorporate with power and authority to perform all the functions as such.
