

ORDER

Now on this 24th day of January, 1980, come the Petitioners, represented by Stephen Choate, and states that the allegations contained in the Petition filed in this cause, are true and correct. After consideration by the Court, and the County Judge finding that there was no person present in opposition to the annexation nor was anyone present contending that the statements and allegations contained in the Petition were not true and correct.

Therefore, the Court being sufficiently advised as to all matters of fact and law, finds that the following described territory should be annexed into the City of Higden, Cleburne County, Arkansas, with said property being more particularly described as follows:

A part of Fractional Sections 19 and 30, Township Eleven North, Range Eleven West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Cleburne County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows:

All that part of Fractional Sections 19 and 30 lying North of Arkansas State Highway 16 & 92 and West of the Center of Arkansas State Highway 336 which is South of the existing corporate limits of the town of Higden, Arkansas, less and except all that property taken by the United States of America for Greers Ferry Reservoir, and also parts of Fractional Sections 19 and 30, described as proceeding from the Northwest Corner of the NW% of the SE% of Section 19, then East along the Quarter Section line a distance of 99 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning on the Fee Taking Line of Greers Ferry Reservoir, then Southeasterly along the Fee Taking Line to the Southeast Corner of Bates Subdivision (G.F. Bdy. Mon. No. 1222-2-2) then N89^o06'10"W, 1,167.95 feet, more or less to the center of Arkanaga State Wighten 236 of Arkansas State Highway 336, then South along the center of Highway 336, a distance of 1651.91 feet, more or less, to a point which is 331.30 feet South of the North line of Fractional Section 30, then East 1320 feet, more or less, to a point on the West line of the Narrows Public use area, then South along said line to the North Right-of-Way line of Arkansas State Highway No. 16 & 92, then Southwesterly along said Right-of-Way line to a point which intersects the center of Arkansas State Highway No. 336, then North along the

center of Highway 336, 3900 feet, more or less, to the South line of the existing corporate limits for the town of Higden, Arkansas, then following the existing corporate limits in an Easterly and Northerly direction to the Point of Beginning, containing approximately 250 acres, more or less.


