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#### Abstract

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE FOURCHE CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY ANNEXATION; TO ADD CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, a petition for voluntary annexation (the "Petition") was filed with the County Clerk of Pulaski County, Arkansas, by the owner of hereinafter designated lands praying that said lands be annexed to and made part of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2011, the County Court of Pulaski County, Arkansas, found that the Petition was signed by a majority of the total number of the real property owners of the area to be annexed and by the owners of some 212.5 acres of said area; and,

WHEREAS, said lands are contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of the City of Little Rock; and,

WHEREAS, an accurate map of said lands has been filed with and made a part of said Petition; and,
WHEREAS, proper notice has been given for the time and in the manner prescribed by law; and,
WHEREAS, all things pertaining thereto have been done in the manner prescribed by law and that said lands should be annexed to and made part of the City of Little Rock.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The following described territory contiguous and adjoining the City of Little Rock, Arkansas is accepted as annexed to and made a part of the City of Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas, to wit:

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

## Tract 1

All of the $S^{1} / 2$ of the $N^{1} 1 / 4$, and the $N^{1 / 2}$ of the $S W 1 / 4$ of Section 23, and a part of the $S^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{NE}^{1} / 4$, and the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE}^{1} / 4$, of Section 22, $\mathrm{T}-1-\mathrm{N}, \mathrm{R}-11-\mathrm{W}$, of the 5th Principal Meridian, Pulaski County, Arkansas ( 9500 Birdwood Drive), being more particularly described as. follows:


Commencing at a found PK nail, said PK nail being the NW Corner of the $\mathrm{S}^{1 / 2}$ of the NE $1 / 4$ of Section 22 ; thence $S 6^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 20^{\prime \prime}$ E, to a found $1 / 2$-inch rebar, said $1 / 2$-inch rebar also being on the east right-of-way line of Frazier Pike (a 120 -foot right-of-way), a distance of 59.67 feet, and the Point of Beginning for the land herein described; thence $\mathrm{S} 87^{\circ} 50^{\prime} 03^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the south line of Little Rock Port Industrial Park, a distance of 1546.71 feet to a set $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{S} 29^{\circ} 12^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the west right-of-way of the Fourche Island Drainage District \#2, (a seventy (70)-foot right-of-way), a distance of 1347.29 feet to a set $1 / 2$ inch rebar with cap; thence continue along said right-of-way, $\mathrm{S} 75^{\circ} 45^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, to the west line of the $\mathrm{S}^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{NW} 1 / 4$ of Section 23, a distance of 310.33 feet to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{N} 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the west line of said $\mathrm{S}^{1 / 2}$ of the $\mathrm{NW}^{1 / 4}$, a distance of 1218.61 feet to the NW Corner of the $\mathrm{S}^{1 / 2}$ of the $\mathrm{NW}{ }^{1 / 4}$ of Section 23 ; thence $\mathrm{S} 87^{\circ} 50^{\prime} 15^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the North line of the $\mathrm{S}^{1 / 2}$ of the $\mathrm{NW}^{1 / 4}$ of Section 23, a distance of 2640.53 feet, to the NE Corner of the $\mathrm{S}^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{NW} 1 / 4$ of Section 23 ; thence $\mathrm{S} 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, along the East line of the $\mathrm{S} 1 / 2$ of the NW $1 / 4$ of Section 23, a distance of 1328.53 feet, to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap for the SE Corner of the $\mathrm{S}^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{NW} \mathrm{W}^{1} / 4$ of Section 23 ; thence continue $\mathrm{S} 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, along the east line of the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SW} 1 / 4$ of Section 23 , a distance of 1328.29 feet, to a found $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap being the SE Corner of said $\mathrm{N}^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SW} \mathrm{K}^{1}$ of Section 23 ; thence $\mathrm{N} 87^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 20^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, 2636.25 feet to the SW Corner of said $\mathrm{N}^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SW}{ }^{1} / 4$; thence $\mathrm{N} 87^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 20^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 100.00 feet, to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap; thence N01 ${ }^{\circ} 22^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of 1328.38 feet to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{N} 73^{\circ} 41^{\prime} 19$ "W, a distance of 286.37 feet, to a found $5 / 8$ inch rebar; thence $\mathrm{N}^{2} 9^{\circ} 12^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 239.17 feet, to a found $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{S} 60^{\circ} 47^{\prime} 27^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 80.00 feet to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{N} 29^{\circ} 12^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 200.00 feet to a set $1 / 2^{- \text {-inch }}$ rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{N} 60^{\circ} 47^{\prime} 27^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of 80.00 feet to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap; thence $\mathrm{N} 29^{\circ} 12^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 910.34 feet, to a found $1 / 2$-inch rebar; thence $\mathrm{N} 87^{\circ} 50^{\prime} 03^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar and cap on the east right-of-way of Frazier Pike (a 120 -foot right-of-way), a distance of 1471.42 feet; thence $\mathrm{N} 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 34$ " E , along said right-of-way, a distance of 100.03 feet to the Point of Beginning containing $7,498,605$ square-feet or 172.14 acres, more or less.

## Tract 2

All lands lying south of and west of the centerline of Old Fourche Creek being a part of the SW $1 / 4$ of the NE $1 / 4$ of Section 23, T-1-N, R-11-W of the 5th Principal Meridian, Pulaski County, Arkansas, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a found $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap, said rebar and cap also being the SE Corner of the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SW} \mathrm{W}^{1}$, of Section 23, T-1-N, R-11-W, thence $\mathrm{N} 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the
west line of the $N 1 / 2$ of the $S W 1 / 4$ of Section 23, a distance of 1328.29 feet to a set $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap for the SW Corner of the said SW $1 / 4$ of the $\mathrm{NE}^{1 / 4}$ of Section 23 and the Point of Beginning; thence N $01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ E, along said west line of said SW $1 / 4$ of the $N E 1 / 4$ of Section 23, to a point on the centerline of Old Fourche Creek, a distance of 225.00 feet; thence meandering along said centerline of Old Fourche Creek, the following bearings and distances; S $89^{\circ} 25^{\prime} 32^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of 187.40 feet; $\mathrm{N} 69^{\circ} 13^{\prime} 39^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of sixty-two (62) feet; thence $\mathrm{N} 86^{\circ} 11^{\prime} 09^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of 345.70 feet; thence $\mathrm{S} 23^{\circ} 51^{\prime} 14^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, to the South line of the said $\mathrm{SW}^{1 / 4}$ of the $\mathrm{NE}^{1 / 4}$ of Section 23, a distance of 323.90 feet; thence $\mathrm{N} 87^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, along the South line of the $\mathrm{SW} 1 / 4$ of the $\mathrm{NE}^{1} / 4$ of Section 23, 728.10 feet to the Point of Beginning, said lands contained within the above described tract comprised of approximately 170,737 square-feet or 3.90 acres, more or less.

## Tract 3

All lands lying south of and west of the centerline of Old Fourche Creek and all accretions all lying within the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE}^{1} / 4$ of Section $23, \mathrm{~T}-1-\mathrm{N}$ R-11-W, of the 5th Principal Meridian, Pulaski County, Arkansas, said $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE}^{1} / 4$ Section 23, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a found $1 / 2$-inch rebar with cap, for the Point of Beginning, said found $1 / 2$ inch rebar with cap, also being the SW Corner of the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE} 1 / 4$ of Section $23, \mathrm{~T}-1-\mathrm{N}, \mathrm{R}-$ 11-W; thence $N 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the west line of the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE}^{1} / 4$ of Section 23 , a distance of $1,328.29$ feet to a set $1 / 2$ rebar and cap for the NW Corner of the $\mathrm{N}^{1} / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE}^{1 / 4}$ of Section 23; thence $S 87^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along the north line of said $\mathrm{N}^{1 / 2}$ of the $\mathrm{SE} \mathrm{E}^{1 / 4}$, to the NE Corner of the $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE} 1 / 4$ of Section 23, a distance of $2,642.69$ feet; thence $\mathrm{S} 01^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of $1,329.20$ feet to the SE Corner of said $\mathrm{N} 1 / 2$ of the $\mathrm{SE}^{1} / 4$ of Section 23; thence $\mathrm{N} 87^{\circ} 45^{\prime} 21^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of $2,642.69$ feet to the Point of Beginning, said lands contained within the above described tract comprised of approximately 1,589,940 square-feet or 36.50 acres, more or less.

Subject to the following:

1. Easement to Fourche Island Drainage District No. 2, recorded in Deed Book 504, Page 437, records of Pulaski County, Arkansas.
2. Overflowing, submerging, and flooding rights, etc., of the United States of America, as set out in Civil Case \#LR-67-C-131, and judgment in United States District Court recorded in Book 25, Page 54.
3. Warranty Easement Deed Number 201071381, recorded in the records of Pulaski County, Arkansas.

The lands consist of a total of $9,259,282$ square-feet or 213 acres, more or less.

Together with all adjacent and abutting streets and rights-of-way.
Section 2. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions of the City in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
