MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF MCCRORY, ARKANSAS  
APRIL 8, 1974

The City Council of the City of McCrory, Arkansas, met in regular session Seven Thirty in the evening, April 8, 1974, at the Municipal Building. Meeting called to order by Mayor Taylor. On roll call the following members were present: Alderman Ball, Golden, Harrison, Ridge; Mayor Taylor and Recorder Lois Alumbaugh. Absent, Alderman Griffin and Alumbaugh. A quorum was declared.

The minutes of the meeting of March 11, 1974 were read and there being no corrections or alterations they were approved as read. The reports of the City Officials were read and approved.

Upon request W. William Graham, Jr., Inc. consulting engineers made a study on the utilization of the 50,000 gallon elevated storage tank. Mr. W. William Graham, Jr. and Jerry Holder gave the study for utilization of 50,000 gallon elevated storage tank located along Missouri Pacific Railroad and passed around maps of proposed water system improvements. They recommended the installation of a pump station, 8" line from tank to E. Raney Ave., 6" line from Seaman to S. Edmonds. Motion by Alderman Golden, second by Alderman Ball, to except the recommendations of our engineers and give them the authority to proceed with purchasing of the materials at the lowest bid, and this to be paid out of Revenue Sharing. Motion Carried.

Mayor Taylor introduces an ordinance entitled "Regulations for the location of trailers within the city and setting forth the minimum requirements for trailer park construction." The clerk read the ordinance the first time in its entirety.

Alderman Harrison moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance placed on its second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Ridge. On the clerk's calling the roll, the following vote resulted: Ayes - Ball, Golden, Harrison and Ridge. The mayor declared the motion carried as there were four Ayes and no Nays. Mayor declared passage of ordinance since Alderman Alumbaugh and Griffin were absent and would not vote. The ordinance was read the second time and the mayor declared the ordinance open for discussion.

Alderman Ridge then moved that the rules be further suspended and the ordinance be placed on its third and final reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Golden. On the clerk's calling the roll, the following vote resulted: Aye's - Ball, Golden, Harrison and Ridge. The mayor declared the motion carried as there were four Ayes and no Nays, four being necessary for passage. The Clerk then read the ordinance the third and final time. The mayor declared the ordinance open for discussion.

The mayor then put the question, 'Shall the ordinance pass?' On the clerk's calling the roll, the following resulted: Ayes - Ball, Golden, Harrison and Ridge. The mayor declared the ordinance passed as there were four Ayes and no Nays.

Whereupon, the Mayor declared said motion duly passed and that the same shall go into effect immediately without delay.

Said ordinance, to which no amendment was offered, read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 151-A

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE LOCATION OF TRAILERS WITHIN THE CITY AND SETTING FORTH THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAILER PARK CONSTRUCTION."

Mayor Taylor ask the City Council to request a grant on the following resolutions.

RESOLUTION NO. 74-1

"A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A LEASE BETWEEN MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AND THE CITY OF MCCRORY FOR LAND THE EXISTING WATER TOWER IS ON."

The resolution was read and discussed and passed. Motion to adopt said resolution was made by Alderman Golden and second by Alderman Ball. It was unanimous of the favor being no corrections.

Mayor Taylor brought before the City Council the request for a grant the following resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 74-2

"A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF MCCRORY, ARKANSAS, North Half fo the Northeast Quarter ( $N\frac{1}{2}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eleven (11) Township Seven (7) North, Range Two(2) West; containing 80 acres, more or less.

The resolution was read and discussed and passed. Motion to adopt said resolution was made by Alderman Harrison and second by Alderman Ridge. It was unanimous in favor.

After reading of the bills, motion by alderman Harrison and second by Alderman Ridge to pay the following bills. Motion carried.

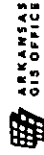
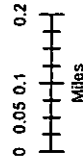
